<p><b>Title</b></p>	<p><b>E-learning - new quality of education</b></p>
<p><b>Resume</b></p>	<p>The project was financed by the European Union under the European Social Fund Operational Programme Human Capital. The idea behind the project is to extend e-learning on the core general subjects of baccalaureate and on the vocational subjects.</p> <p>Participation in the project was free and voluntary. Courses (learning activities) in every general and vocational subject, conducted by teachers involved in the project, were created on the Moodle e-learning platform. Teachers publish educational materials in various forms: teaching content, presentations, exercises to be performed, tests to be solved, etc. Every participant has the opportunity to participate actively in the teaching of selected courses. Through the learning platform is possible to download and print all posted teaching materials, to exercise tasks set by teacher, send solutions to exercises and tests, active participation in the proposed forms of communication with teachers and other participants.</p>

<b>Duration</b>	01.11.2008. – 31.07.2010.
<b>Activities</b>	Promotion, recruitment of participants, the training of listeners participating in the project, implementation of e-learning education, conference <i>E-learning - a new quality of education</i> .
<b>Results</b>	The project has enabled the continuation of schooling for the mishap, causing temporary absence from the classes in the school, provided better preparation for baccalaureate and vocational exams, allowed for the acquisition of learning skills in e-learning and develop self-discipline and regularity.
<b>Products</b>	e-Learning platform was implemented. In the duration of the project 393 courses in various subjects, both general and professional (eg an economist technician, dealer technician, automotive technician, accounting technician) were created, and 2,560 hours of teaching materials and e-learning didactic materials were published.
<b>Language</b>	Polish
<b>Innovation</b>	Introducing modern teaching technologies.
<b>Transferability</b>	Yes, the project activities may be repeated in other training institutions. Created courses can be used to teach classes with the corresponding profile.
